

Musgrave honors Korean war vets

In Nov. 8 ceremony

Congresswoman Marilyn Musgrave, district 4, honored 49 Colorado veterans of the Korean War by presenting them with a Republic of Korea War Service Medal Saturday.

Musgrave hosted the ceremony in Greeley to recognize the 50th Anniversary of the Korean War Armistice and present qualified veterans with a medal.
